

BUYER'S RESPONSIBILITY:

In this document, the names 'Breeder' and 'Seller' will refer to *Robertson's Retrievers and Doodles*.

1. Choose a veterinarian and take your puppy for a wellness examination within **three business days** of leaving *Robertson's Retrievers and Doodles*. Failure to do so renders the *Health Guarantee* null and void.
 - A. Schedule future appropriate veterinary appointments for your puppy to remain healthy and up-to-date on all vaccinations throughout its lifetime.
 - B. Avoid your puppy coming into contact with any unvaccinated canine before having their full veterinarian-recommended vaccination series, including rabies, distemper, parvovirus, bordetella, etc.
 - C. Puppies are susceptible to ailments upon transitioning to their new home. Urinary tract infections, parasites, and ear infections are common in young puppies. You are responsible for treating and caring for your puppy once it leaves the Breeder's home.

2. **Spay/Neuter Timing Recommendation:** We recommend waiting until your puppy is at least six (6) months old before spaying or neutering. For females, allowing at least one heat cycle has been recommended to support healthy development. The ideal timing should be determined in consultation with your veterinarian, based on your dog's breed, sex, size, and health. Studies suggest spaying/neutering too early can increase the risk of joint issues, urinary incontinence, and certain cancers. Hormones from a female's heat cycle play a role in physical maturation, particularly in bladder and joint health. The American Kennel Club (AKC) advises a case-by-case approach and recommends consulting your veterinarian for the best outcome.
 - A. Your ownership is conditioned upon paying all costs and expenses to spay/neuter your puppy no later than the age of 2 years. Immediately after your puppy is spayed/neutered, notify the Breeder with proof of the procedure from your veterinarian.
3. Your puppy is not for resale. The Breeder and Buyer agree that the purchased puppy is being acquired as a family companion and will live in a comfortable home. The Buyer agrees that the puppy will never be used or trained for illegal activities. Additionally, a female **may not** be bred without purchasing breeding rights from the Breeder.
4. The Breeder's puppies sell as '**non-breedable**' with an option to purchase breeding rights. All puppies sold without breeding rights must complete #2 as outlined above, or failure to do so will terminate your *Health Guarantee*, considered a breach of contract, and a fine can be assessed.
5. Except for a severe, genuine health problem covered within the *Health Guarantee*, there will be **NO REFUNDS**.
